### Observation

What does Jesus say about this generation and their expectations?

Although John the Baptist and Jesus were both criticized, what does Jesus tell the people to look at?

Why do you think John the Baptist asked if Jesus was the Messiah?  
How would you answer the question, "who do you believe Jesus is?"  
In your experience, what caused you to believe Jesus is the Messiah?

How do your expectations of Christ line up with Scripture?

### Structured Prayer

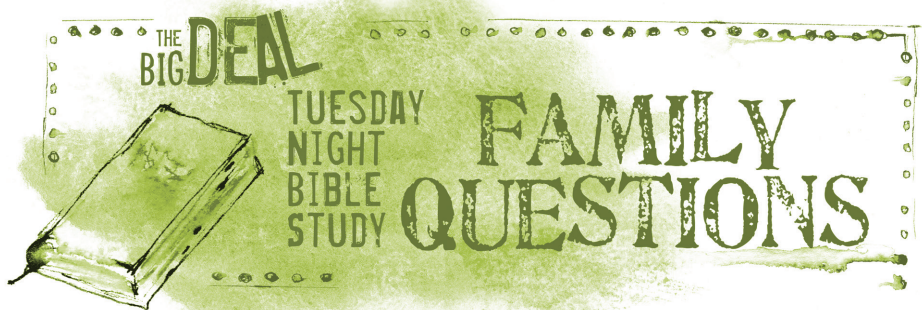
Pray and thank God for sending His Son to die for your sins. Ask God to give you wisdom on how to share what you believe.
